2. Creation should be original design created by the competitor and not a kit or project found online or in magazine.
3. One entry per participant.
4. Make sure your project is labeled with: Title of Project, Your Name, Grade, Phone #
5. Projects must be delivered to (Name of library and address) on (date) between the hours of (time).
6. Participants must be taken home by (date & time) or they will become property of the library.

After the judging, the entries will be placed on exhibit in the library. The awards ceremony will take place on (date & time) with the doors opening at (time). A reception follow the awards ceremony.
